The Judges of the State Court of Gwinnett County are now accepting applications for the position of Judge of the Gwinnett County Recorder's Court. This full-time position will fill the unexpired term of Judge Katherine Armstrong, beginning on or about January 1, 2027, and continuing through December 31, 2028.

Applicants shall possess the same qualifications as the Judges of the State Court of Gwinnett County. Specifically, a qualified Applicant shall:

- (a) Be a resident of Gwinnett County;
- (b) Have been a resident of the state for the three (3) years preceding the beginning of the appointed term;
- (c) Be at least 25 years of age on the date the appointed term begins;
- (d) Have been admitted to the practice of law for at least seven (7) years; and
- (e) Be a member in good standing with the State Bar of Georgia.

To be considered, a completed Application Package must be received by the Administrative Office of the Courts **on or before 4:00 p.m. on October 2, 2026** using **one** of the following methods:
