Law Day Legal Information Fair

The Gwinnett County Bar Association, in partnership with the Gwinnett Pro Bono Project and Gwinnett Legal Aid, is excited to host a Legal Information Fair in the auditorium breezeway at the Gwinnett Justice and Administration Center, on Wednesday, May 4, 2016 from 10am to 4pm. We will provide free legal advice and information to as many people as possible on that day in the following areas: family law, wills and powers of attorney, probate, and consumer and bankruptcy questions. The Legal Information Fair is FREE and is open to all residents of Gwinnett County or people with a legal action in Gwinnett County.

This event is hosted as part of the Gwinnett County Bar Association's celebration of Law Day. On May 1, every year, the United States officially recognizes Law Day. It is a national holiday created to reflect on the role of law in the foundation of the country and to recognize its importance for society. The American Bar Association designates a theme to highlight an important issue relating to the law or legal system. This year's Law Day theme is Miranda: More than Words, which celebrates ALL the rights guaranteed by the Constitution. One essential right is the right to counsel. While we cannot guarantee everyone representation in every civil case, we are joining together to give people information and advice in honor of Law Day this year.
